### Jubilate Spring Concert

Come enjoy an inspiring music-filled evening. Jubilate Community Youth Choir of Warwick will perform an eclectic repertoire of sacred, secular, modern and ancient choral works at its Spring Concert on Friday June 19, 2009 at 7pm at the serene and scenic Mulder Chapel at The Warwick Center, off Hoyt Rd. in Warwick. Featured guest performers are jazz pianist and composer Richard Kimball and soprano Jody Weatherstone. Tickets are \$10 and are available through the ticket line 845-469-8100. This concert is generously underwritten by the law offices of Joseph Donohue, Warwick.

Since its inception in 2006, Jubilate has quadrupled in size. In 2008 a baritone choir was added to accommodate the changing voices of young men who are no longer right for a treble choir yet want to remain with Jubilate. Jubilate now has three choirs: treble, tenor/bass, and full SATB.

Richard Kimball (<http://www.warwickinfo.net/rkimball.html>) of Warwick is a renowned composer and pianist, known for combining his creative musical work with social consciousness. He now concentrates his performance work on piano, performing concerts, playing night club gigs, and accompanying and recording with various vocalists, most notably with the great jazz singer Vivian Lord. He's well known in New York for his thirty years as a house pianist at The River Café. Kimball holds two degrees in composition from the Juilliard School and has an extensive background as a bass player, synthesizer player and pianist in orchestra, rock, jazz and Brazilian groups. He's a prize-winning composer and has taught composition at Juilliard and the Manhattan School of Music.

Jody Weatherstone (<http://www.jodyweatherstone.com>) of Warwick's versatility and flexibility as a singer and actress have led her to perform in a wide range of venues, from musical theater to oratorio. She has appeared with the Delaware Valley Opera, with the NYU Choral Arts Society, at Cami Hall in recital, is a frequent guest soloist with Classic Choral Society, and tours extensively. A graduate of NYU with a degree in Voice and Theatre, plus a master's in Food Studies and an alumnus of the Institute of Culinary Education, Jody has combined her performing experience and knowledge of culinary arts in several television food venues, and writes for numerous food publications and cookbooks. She is soprano soloist at St. Mary's church in Tuxedo Park, NY and maintains a private voice studio in Warwick.

Established in 2006 in Warwick, Jubilate (pronounced yoo-buh-lah-tey) is a thirty-five member, co-ed choir of talented young people. Christ Church, Warwick sponsors the choir and provides rehearsal space. Jubilate has performed at local houses of worship, public concerts, community events, St. Paul's Chapel at Ground Zero, a Sussex Skyhawks baseball game, and with locally and nationally-known artists in the pop, bluegrass, folk, rock and classical music genres. Music director David Crone, assistant director Steven Wing, and chorus manager Anne Barker work in local school systems and are accomplished musicians in their own right.
